

## **RESOLUTION #1 RECOGNIZING AND CONDEMNING THE ARMENIAN GENOCIDE**

WHEREAS the Armenian Genocide was a crime against humanity planned and executed by the government of the Ottoman Empire (Turkey) against its Armenian subjects; and

WHEREAS the Armenian Genocide may have served as inspiration for the Holocaust; and

WHEREAS the United States has officially recognized the Armenian Genocide since 1951 through government written statement, presidential proclamation, and House joint resolutions; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the California Republican Assembly declares its support for H.R. 296, which concludes with the following:

*“Resolved,* That it is the sense of the House of Representatives that it is the policy of the United States to—

- (1) commemorate the Armenian Genocide through official recognition and remembrance;
- (2) reject efforts to enlist, engage, or otherwise associate the United States Government with denial of the Armenian Genocide or any other genocide; and
- (3) encourage education and public understanding of the facts of the Armenian Genocide, including the United States role in the humanitarian relief effort, and the relevance of the Armenian Genocide to modern-day crimes against humanity.”
